





While some partners focused on collecting and interpreting the results from both charters, others worked on sharing updates and key messages through social media and online platforms to keep our wider community engaged. All partner organisations collaborated closely to discuss the findings and explore the best ways to deliver meaningful outcomes. One of the main challenges we faced was encouraging consistent participation—while many stakeholders completed the first charter, maintaining the same level of engagement for the second proved difficult. Despite this, the insights gathered have been invaluable in shaping our next steps and ensuring we are sustainable in our mobilities.




Partner organisations also took part in an evaluation form reflecting on how the project was managed and their overall experience, which proved to be a valuable and positive exercise for everyone involved.
